### What is the Sports Funding?

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum over the academic years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 to improve the quality of sport and PE in primary schools. For Deeplish this will equate to £8736.

### Our PE Vision

At Deeplish we endeavour to ensure that teaching and learning opportunities in PE are high quality, meeting the needs of all pupils to enable them to reach their sporting potential. We provide a broad and balanced P.E. curriculum throughout the school both within school time and outside of school hours. We believe that physical education and sport contribute to the holistic development of young people and through participation in sport and physical education, our pupils will learn more about key values such as teamwork, fair play and respect for both themselves and others.

### Our Spending Plan 2014-15

Having audited our current P.E. provision we have decided to spend our funding in ways which will ensure it has a long lasting impact on the teaching and learning of physical education at Deeplish. Whilst also giving children access to high quality coaching from external specialists.
